March 11 - Beijing	Visit Tiananmen Square and Forbidden City in the morning, Hutong tour in the afternoon. (B,L)

## Quote

The quote is divided into 2 segments – the basic tour and the orphanage visit.

### Basic Tour:

5 star accommodations – Beijing – Chongqing – Yangtze Cruise – Yichang – Shanghai

All fees are quoted in US dollars and are per person. Children aged 12 and up are considered adults for travel purposes in China.

Each room will have 2 double beds.

1 Adult + 1 Child	\$1980 + \$1595 (double occupancy)
2 Adults + 1 Child	\$1980 x 2 + \$1595 (with roll-away bed) (double occupancy)
2 Adults	\$1980 x 2 (double occupancy)

The above quotation includes:

A welcome at the airport and escort to hotel, **5 star** hotel accommodations, meals as per itinerary, sightseeing and entrance fees, guide service, flights from Beijing - Chongqing – Yichang - Shanghai, all taxes.

### Orphanage Visit

The cost for the orphanage visit will vary depending on the city but will average about \$660USD per adult and \$530USD per child (including airfare from Beijing – provincial capital – Chongqing, accommodations, transportation to orphanage, guide, etc.).

\*In-China travel includes: hotel, guide service, some meals (as outlined on itinerary), sightseeing, cruise and flights from Beijing – Chongqing – Yichang - Shanghai, all taxes.

Additional costs for province/orphanage visits will vary. The average fee will be \$660USD per adult and \$530USD per child as outlined above.

Please note: There may be other costs that will vary. All international flights and in-China travel fees are set and charged by third parties and must be paid at the current rate at the time they are due. There is a \$150.00 administrative fee payable to The Children's Bridge for any *additional* (not including adoptive parents and/or siblings) passengers travelling to China.

There may be changes from when you initially received this cost information until you receive a final quote for your in-China travel (approximately 60 days prior to travel). In-China travel fees are based on a travel group of at least 10 adults. Adults are travellers aged 12 and older. This applies to fares on international flights as well as in-China travel fees.

# HOMELAND VISIT ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

The costs per family are listed below. Please note that children ages 12 and up are considered adults for travel in China.

Hotels are family friendly and rated 5 stars in China. They were selected for their location and comfort and are more than suitable for the average family. They all have pools as well as a variety of restaurants nearby with a varied choice of food. In Beijing the hotel is close to both western style and Chinese restaurants. Hotels in each province are to be confirmed at a later date.

Indicate by checking the appropriate box which option you prefer. Payment for the in-China travel is due no later than February 6, 2012. Cheques are made payable to "The Children's Bridge In Trust". This payment will be wired to the travel coordinators in China as payment for hotel arrangements, guides and air travel within China. Should you not be able to come on the tour, cancellation penalties will apply as noted.

# ORPHANAGE VISIT ARRANGEMENTS

## PERMISSION & INVITATION TO VISIT

The Children's Bridge will be pleased to arrange a visit to your child's orphanage family. Your request will be made through the Department of Civil Affairs in the province in China from where your child was adopted. Such visits are approved both by the Department of Civil Affairs and the Director of your child's orphanage. While every effort will be made on your behalf to visit the orphanage, there is no guarantee that it will be allowed.

In order to make the request, the following *adoption documents* are required:

1. Copy of your child's Adoption Certificate with complete Chinese name, year of adoption, birth date etc. in English AND Chinese.
2. Name of orphanage, orphanage city and province in China.

In addition to the above, you will need to write a letter addressed to your orphanage introducing yourselves and requesting an invitation to visit. Include this letter with the attached documents. A sample letter is below.

***To: Director of the <insert name> Social Welfare Institute***

***We are the <insert name> family from <insert city>, Canada. We are in China to visit and to experience the wonderful heritage of this beautiful country. ## TRAVEL COSTS

There will be additional costs involved if you choose to visit your child's orphanage city as outlined above. This cost will vary depending on the following factors:

- how far the orphanage is from the provincial capital
- the number of orphanages you wish to visit
- the type of transportation necessary to travel to the orphanage city (car, bus, train or airplane)
- cost of guide and his/her travel/hotel arrangements
- the number of families going to the same orphanage (greater number will mean decreased cost)

It will take approximately 2-4 weeks to determine this additional cost. Your patience is requested while we obtain a quote. As soon as we receive a quote we will advise you so that you can make a decision.

## TASK LIST

You need to:

- Ensure all travellers have received necessary immunizations. Twinrix (recommended) must be started 6 months prior to travel. Dukoral is also recommended for all travellers.
- Return Homeland Visit Registration form (3 pages), Orphanage Visit Request Form (2 pages), Orphanage visit request invitation form, Accommodation Option form (1 page), Travel Arrangements form (3 pages), Add-on Trip Planner (2 pages), China Application for Homeland Visit, and payment of \$600 non-refundable registration fee by October 28, 2011.
- Copies of pages 2 and 3 of each traveller's passport must be submitted with registration form above.
- We will book your international flights and insurance or you can book directly with the airline or agency of your choice (using points if you choose to). If you book flights yourself, book to arrive in Beijing March 10, 2012 and provide us with copies of your e-tickets ASAP.
- Every person travelling must have a Chinese visa. Please complete your visa application forms (attached) and send to CB with your valid passports (original passport – no copies), 2 colour visa sized pictures (2" x 2") and the fee of \$150.00 per application and submit by February 6, 2012. **Note that passports must be signed and valid for 6 months following dates of travel.** An instruction form is also attached to assist you in filling out your visa application.
- Please note that a Power of Attorney is required if one parent is NOT travelling. Contact us for a sample form.
- **If this is your child's first trip back to China, please include their red Chinese passport with above visa application.**
- Send us a fun, clear picture of your child(ren) as well as the Kids Travel Journal Publication Release Form by January 6, 2012.
